The entire All Star Children's Foundation campus is a nurturing community designed to ensure the healing of neglected and abused children.


WHAT MATTERS MOST IS THE SIZE OF YOUR HEART

Here's What You Can Expect

- Living in a new home specifically constructed for convenient childcare and featuring beautiful interior design that supports a trauma-informed environment.
- \$1,800 monthly rent, offset by up to \$400 per month for a utility credit, plus a daily board rate per child.
- 10 hours per week free support for daily needs such as child care, light housekeeping, and other chores.
- Clothing allowance twice per year, per child.
- Access to an onsite children's boutique, food pantry and a vegetable garden.



Here's What We Expect

- You are interested in learning a new approach to foster parenting.
- You want to understand the meaning behind troubling behavior.
- You have a current driver's license, a safe driving record (6 point or less) and vehicle insurance.
- At least one parent must be employed outside the home.
- You must be or willing to become a licensed foster parent in Florida.
